JUSTIFIED BY FAITH

WHY IS JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH SUCH AN IMPORTANT DOCTRINE?

The teaching of justification by faith is what separates biblical Christianity from all other belief systems. In every religion, and in some branches of what is called "Christianity," man is working his way to God. Only in true, biblical Christianity is man saved as a result of grace through faith. Only when we get back to the Bible do we see that justification is by faith, apart from works.

The word justified means "pronounced or treated as righteous." For a Christian, justification is the act of God not only forgiving the believer's sins but imputing to him the righteousness of Christ. The Bible states in several places that justification only comes through faith (e.g., Romans 5:1; Galatians 3:24). Justification is not earned through our own works; rather, we are covered by the righteousness of Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:8; Titus 3:5). The Christian, being declared righteous, is thus freed from the guilt of sin.

Justification is a completed work of God, and it is instantaneous, as opposed to sanctification, which is an ongoing process of growth by which we become more Christlike (the act of "being saved," cf. 1 Corinthians 1:18; 1 Thessalonians 5:23). Sanctification occurs after justification.

Understanding the doctrine of justification is important for a Christian. First, it is the very knowledge of justification and of grace that motivates good works and spiritual growth; thus, justification leads to sanctification. Also, the fact that justification is a finished work of God means that Christians have assurance of their salvation. In God's eyes, believers have the righteousness necessary to gain eternal life.

Once a person is justified, there is nothing else he needs in order to gain entrance into heaven. Since justification comes by faith in Christ, based on His work on our behalf, our own works are disqualified as a means of salvation (Romans 3:28). There exist vast religious systems with complex theologies that teach the false doctrine of justification by works. But they are teaching "a different gospel—which is really no gospel at all" (Galatians 1:6–7).

Without an understanding of justification by faith alone, we cannot truly perceive the glorious gift of grace—God's "unmerited favor" becomes "merited" in our minds, and we begin to think we deserve salvation. The doctrine of justification by faith helps us maintain "pure devotion to Christ" (2 Corinthians 11:3). Holding to justification by faith keeps us from falling for the lie that we can earn heaven. There is no ritual, no sacrament, no deed that can make us worthy of the righteousness of Christ. It is only by His grace, in response to our faith, that God has credited to us the holiness of His Son. Both Old and New Testaments say, "The just shall live by faith" (Habakkuk 2:4; Romans 1:17; Galatians 3:11; Hebrews 10:38).

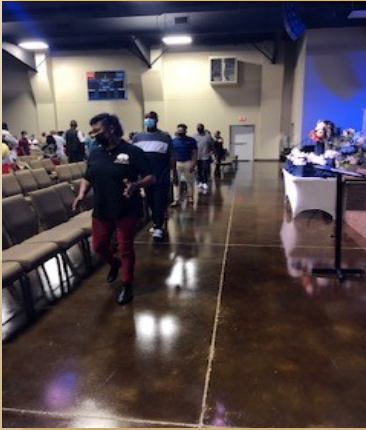

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT JUSTIFICATION BY FAITH

♦ Justification by faith is a whole-Bible doctrine.

Some Christians may be surprised to learn that the doctrine of justification by faith is not only found in the New Testament but in the Old Testament. Genesis tells us that Abraham, in response to God's promise, "believed the LORD, and it was counted to him as righteousness" (Gen. 15:6). Jesus himself teaches this doctrine in his parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector, a parable he told "to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and treated others with contempt" (Luke 18:9).

♦ Justification by faith is articulated most clearly by the apostle Paul.

Most agree that the doctrine of justification by faith is seen most clearly in Paul's letters, and especially in his letters to the Romans and Galatians. Paul sums up the point of his letter to the Romans in Romans 1:17: "For in it [the gospel] the righteousness of God is revealed by faith to faith, as it is written, 'The righteousness shall live by faith.'"

♦ Justification by faith is another way of saying we are not justified by our works.

Justification by faith is the opposite of justification by our works of obedience to the law. As Paul says it in Romans, "we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law" (Rom. 3:28).

♦ Justification by faith does not mean that our faith is the ultimate cause of our justification.

Once again, Paul clearly teaches that we are justified by our faith (e.g., Rom. 3:28). And yet he does not mean by this that our faith is the ultimate reason we are justified. The ultimate reason that we are justified is

this: Christ "was delivered up [by God] for our trespasses and raised [by God] for our justification" (Rom. 4:25).

♦ Justification by faith affirms that good works necessarily follow from faith.

The doctrine of justification by faith excludes our works of obedience to the law as a means or cause of our justification before God. But it also affirms that acts of love and good works necessarily follow from our faith as the fruit of our faith.

♦ Justification by faith results in the inclusion of all believers as God's people.

One necessary conclusion from Paul's doctrine of justification by faith is the idea that God will therefore justify both Jewish believers and Gentile believers. If "all have sinned" and "are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 3:23–24), then it follows that God is the God not only of Jewish believers but of Gentile believers.

♦ Justification by faith is a Protestant doctrine.

The doctrine of justification by faith as we think of it today was formulated by Protestant theologians at the time of the Reformation.

♦ Justification by faith brings glory to God.

There is something about justification by faith that gives particular glory to God. Paul says this of Abraham's faith: "No unbelief made him waver concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong in his faith as he gave glory to God, fully convinced that God was able to do what he had promised" (Rom. 4:20–21).

JUSTIFIED BY FAITH

Justified means delivered or made righteous in the sight of GOD. Faith is trust, assurance, and confidence in God. Living faith is shown by service and obedience to God.

Romans 5:1-21 (ESV) says, "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through

Him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces en-

durance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us."

This is what we have when we have been justified by faith. It is gifted to us by God. No one else can do that for us, no one. Remember that! If we do not have God, we have nothing in His Son, Jesus Christ whom He sent to us to save us and the faith we receive through Him as our Lord, Savior, and Master. Furthermore, Galatians 2:16-17 (ESV) states, Yet we know that a person is not justified

by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified. But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we too were found to be sinners, is Christ then a servant of sin? Certainly not!

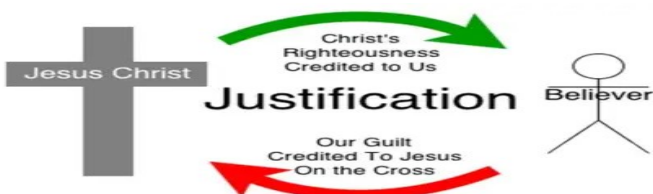
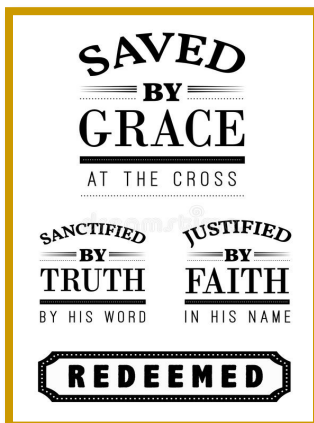

thing? I admonish you today lay aside everything and trust Him, and He will justify you.

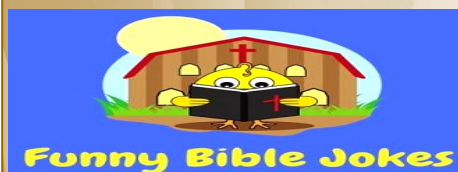

NATIONAL GRANDPARENTS DAY

Grandparents Day is an official national holiday, signed by President Carter on August 3rd 1978 and celebrated on the first Sunday after Labor Day.

The day is celebrated to show the bond between grandparents and their grandchildren.

The statute cites the day's purpose is "to honor grandparents, to give grandparents an opportunity to show love for their children's children, and to help children become aware of strength, information, and guidance older people can offer".

Who Created National Grandparents Day?

It was a housewife in West Virginia, Marian Lucille Herndon McQuade, who initiated the campaign in 1970 to set aside a special day for grandparents.

In 1956, Marian McQuade was helping to organize a community celebration for seniors over 80 when she noticed how many residents of nursing homes seemed to be forgotten. Wanting to remind people of those forgotten individuals and to honor all grandparents, she became the activist responsible for West Virginia becoming the first state to declare a Grandparents Day in 1973. That small step led her and others to the national arena, and in 1978 the observance became a national holiday when President Jimmy Carter signed the proclamation. He recognized Marion McQuade as the founder, saying "I urge each citizen to pause and to reflect on the influence his grandparents have had in shaping his own destiny." Carter added, and on the legacy bestowed upon our contemporary society by his grandparents' generation."

In 2016, President Barack Obama authored a similar proclamation for National Grandparents Day, noting that "Let us continue to show them [our grandparents] the same honor they have shown us."

Even though it was signed in as a national holiday it is celebrated more as an observance than a public holiday and according to card companies, the day is less important for revenue than nine other holidays, including St. Patrick's Day.

Grandparents Day Activities and Gifts!

Most grandparents don't care what activity they do—they just want to spend time with their grandchildren. If you have a grandparent, ask them to show you one of their favorite hobbies. Let your grandparents teach you a skill, like how to fish. Or, perhaps they enjoy garden walks or nature hikes. If your grandparents would prefer a calm day, ask them to show you their favorite classic movie.

Or, perhaps it would be fun to make arts and crafts together. There are a bunch of seasonal crafts to try from

making hollyhock flower dolls to an autumn nut wreath.

Maybe you can bring them some treats, like Grandpa's banana bread or Grandmother's blueberry cake, both made by talented grandparents. Or, try making one of the dishes that your grandparents usually make for you.

If your grandparents does not live nearby, give them a phone call and make them a card! Even if the card doesn't arrive by Grandparents Day, they'll always appreciate a handwritten card which shows

your thoughtfulness.

No matter what, the best Grandparents Day activity involves you and your grandparents together, celebrating your family and each other.

On Grandparents Day, it really is the thought that counts—just make sure your grandparents know that you're thinking of them.

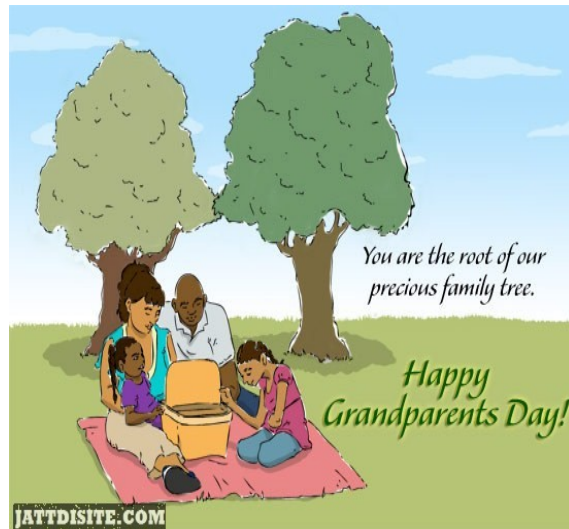
Grandparents Day has both an official flower and song. Both were chosen by the National Grandparents Day Council.
